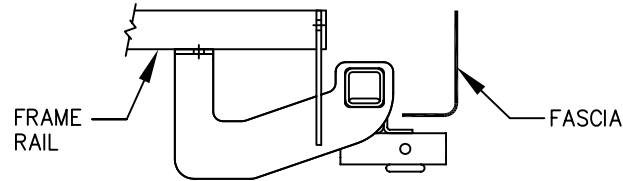
WIRING ACCESS LOCATION: PC1, PC2

DRILL BITS: NONE

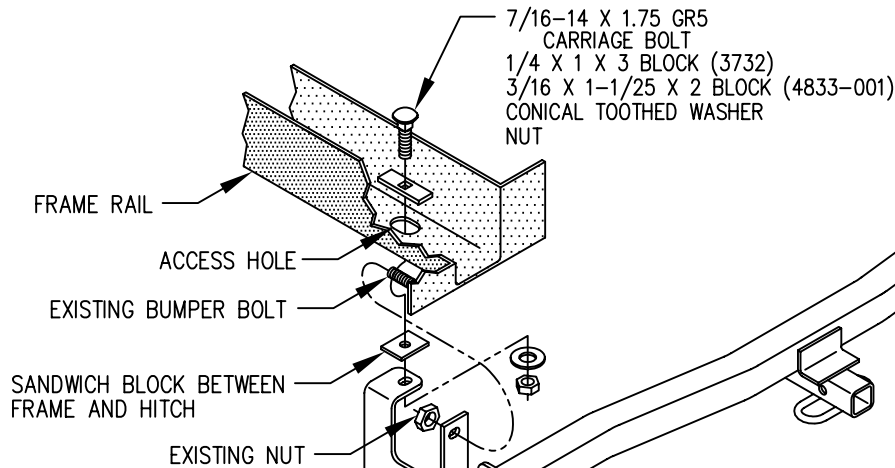
HITCH REQUIRES 1/2" PIN AND CLIP

WRENCHES: (TIGHTEN ALL FASTENERS WITH TORQUE WRENCH) 14mm, 11/16

2000 LB MAX GROSS TRAILER WT
200 LB MAX TONGUE WEIGHT
DO NOT EXCEED TOWING VEHICLE RATINGS



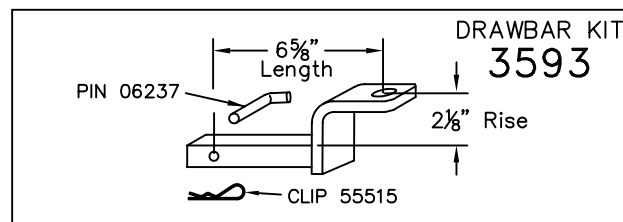
HITCH SHOWN IN PROPER POSITION



1. LOWER VEHICLE EXHAUST.
2. REMOVE TWO (2) BUMPER NUTS.
3. INSTALL CARRIAGE BOLT AND BLOCK (3732) THRU ACCESS HOLE IN FRAME.
4. RAISE HITCH INTO POSITION ON EXISTING BUMPER BOLTS WITH BLOCK (4833-001) BETWEEN FRAME AND HITCH.
5. INSTALL HEXNUTS ON EXISTING BUMPER BOLTS.
6. INSTALL CONICAL WASHERS AND NUTS ONTO CARRIAGE BOLTS.
7. REINSTALL VEHICLE EXHAUST.

TIGHTEN ALL M10 CL8.8 FASTENERS TO 38 LB-FT.

TIGHTEN ALL 1/2 GR5 FASTENERS TO 75 LB-FT.



USE ONLY THE DRAWBAR SHOWN FOR CORRECT BUMPER CLEARANCE AND HEIGHT.
DRAWBAR MUST BE USED IN THE RISE POSITION ONLY.

NOTE: Check hitch frequently, making sure all fasteners and ball are properly tightened. If hitch is removed, plug all holes in trunk pan or other body panels to prevent entry of water and exhaust fumes. A hitch or ball which has been damaged should be removed and replaced. Observe safety precautions when working beneath a vehicle and wear eye protection. Follow car maker's specs for maximum trailer weight and tongue weight. Do not cut access or attachment holes with a torch.
