3. If the information in "n (1)" and "n (2)" is not followed exactly, a fire causing death or serious injury may occur.



Minimum heater clearances from combustible materials: three (3) feet from the sides & two (2) feet from the top.

**CAUTION:** The gas pressure regulator provided with appliance must be used. This regulator is set for an outlet pressure of 11in wc.

The LP-gas supply cylinder must be disconnected when this appliance is not in use.
