

INNOVATION PET® LIMITED WARRANTY

Warrantor extends the following LIMITED WARRANTY to the original Purchaser of this Innovation Pet® product:

1. **Commencement and Term.** For thirty (30) days from the date of original retail purchase, Warrantor will repair or replace, at its option, any part of the Innovation Pet® product which proves upon examination by Warrantor to be defective in material or workmanship. The warranty on any repaired or replacement parts is limited to the unexpired term of the original warranty.

2. **Conditions and Exceptions.** This warranty does not cover:

- a. any damage to the product caused by any animal
- b. any damage resulting from any misuse or abuse of the product
- c. any modification or alteration to, or attempted repair of, the product by Purchaser or any third party; and
- d. any defect arising or discovered more than thirty (30) days from the date of original retail purchase.

3. **Claim Procedure.** Any claim under this warranty must be handled according to the following procedures:

- a. If you suspect a defect in material or workmanship, send an email to CustomerCare@InnovationPet.com to report alleged defect to a customer service representative.
- b. Warrantor will determine if the alleged defect may be covered by this warranty. If it could be covered by this warranty, Warrantor will authorize and instruct the Purchaser how to return the Innovation Pet® product to Warrantor for examination and definitive decision concerning coverage under this warranty.
- c. Warrantor may require Purchaser to present the sales receipt or other proof of purchase prior to authorizing any return or replacement. No returns or replacements will be permitted without prior authorization from Warrantor. If a return or replacement is authorized, Purchaser may be requested to ship the item to Warrantor pursuant to Warrantor's instructions or to make the Innovation Pet® product available for pick-up by Warrantor.
All shipping costs shall be the responsibility of the Purchaser.

4. **Limitation on Implied Warranties.** IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, IMPOSED ON THE SALE OF THE INNOVATION PET® PRODUCT BY STATE LAW, ARE HEREBY EXPRESSLY LIMITED TO A TERM OF THIRTY (30) DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ORIGINAL RETAIL PURCHASE.

INNOVATION PET® CHICKEN COOP CARE

Important Wood Care Instructions:

Extend the Life of Your Coop with Paint or Clear Finish! This coop has been stained, but it is strongly recommended that you paint the wood using a non-toxic outdoor product or seal your coop with a clear polyurethane before assembling. This will add to the life of the coop by providing protection against rain, moisture, humidity and snow. Then treat the wood on your coop like you would any other outdoor wood furniture in your climate. Damage to the coop caused by weather conditions are not covered under the manufacturer's warranty.

Cleaning Instructions:

Hose the surface, and use a mild soap to aid in the removal of dried particles. Do not use bleach or harsh detergents. Ensure that the coop does not sit in puddled water. Allow the coop to dry completely.

Anchoring:

Strong winds can be capable of moving or blowing over chicken coops.

Refer to your local hardware store for techniques and supplies that are recommended to secure outdoor sheds.

Increase Predator Resistance:

- Do not allow chickens to free-range at night. Ensure that all chickens are returned to the enclosure and all coop door latches are secured at dusk.
- During daytime free-ranging, allow chickens to have access to covered areas.
- To protect from nocturnal predators that dig, bury hardware mesh at least 2 feet deep around the entire coop- 4 feet deep would be ideal.
- To protect chickens from birds of prey, cover the pen area with hardware cloth or a tarp.
- To protect against rodents, use feeders that conceal food such as weight activated treadle feeders, and frequently remove any feed that is left on the ground.
- Use commercial and DIY predator deterrents. Many hardware and feed stores will carry owl decoys, electric netting, motion detectors and alarms. Hanging shiny objects such as mirrors and CDs, and placing a scarecrow in the yard are simple and effective ways to deter predators.
- Increase visibility and cut down any tall grass, bush or overgrown areas within 50-75 feet of your coop.
- If there are no restrictions on having roosters in your area, consider adding one to your flock as he will alert and protect hens at first sight of a predator.

Warnings and Reminders:

- Before setting up coop and purchasing chickens, understand your local laws and ordinances.
- Predetermine where the coop will be placed. Always place coop on flat and level ground.
- Move the coop to a safe area if it becomes exposed to strong winds, intense heat or freezing temperatures.
- Do not place heavy objects on the coop.
- Altering the construction of the coop may weaken the structure or lessen security.
- Check periodically that all hardware, such as bolts and screws, are tightly secured.
- Regularly inspect the coop for signs of pests such as ants, termites and wasps that may damage the coop or harm the chickens.
- Avoid heat lamps due to high fire risk.
- Additional protection may be required to maximize predator protection.
- Utilize online resources to research expert advice on raising chickens.
