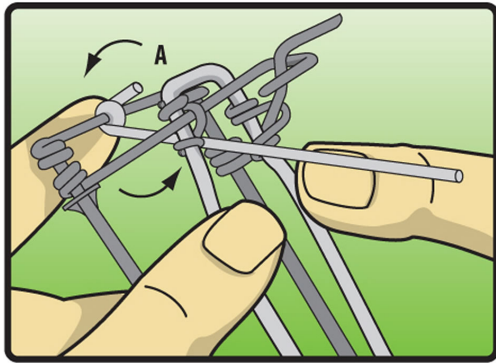
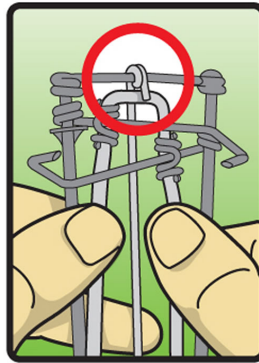


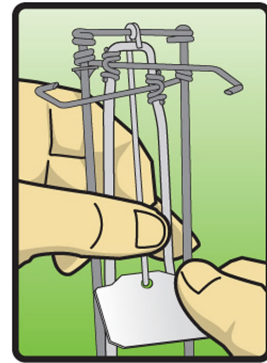
INSTRUCTIONS – Setting the Trap



STEP 1. With index finger, rotate **SETTING ROD (A)** so **TRIP LEVER/SETTING ROD** are correctly positioned as shown.



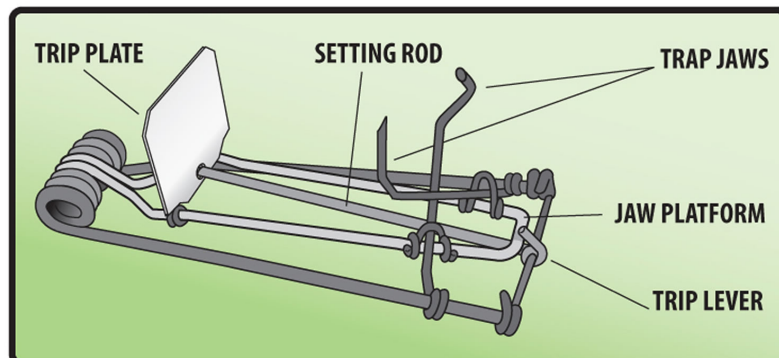
STEP 2. Push down on **JAW PLATFORM** with both thumbs while hooking **TRIP LEVER**.



STEP 3. Keep thumb pressure on **SETTING ROD** while setting it through hole in **TRIP PLATE**.

This is how the activated trap looks.

CAUTION: NEVER STORE AN ACTIVATED TRAP.



Setting traps near fresh mound activity: Dig a small hole in the mound, place the trap in the hole, cover the hole lightly leaving enough room for the gopher to re-enter.

Setting traps in the main tunnel: To find a main tunnel, probe near the mound with a rod to see where the tunnel goes. Set two traps 12-18" apart in the main tunnel (see illustration), one in each direction. Make sure the hole is covered so light does not enter.

Trap retrieval: Tie a string to the trap and secure to stake above the ground. Once a gopher is caught, the trap should be set at a different location. Most captures occur within 48 hours.
