Emission Control System Warranty Statement**

YOUR WARRANTY RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Massimo Motor Sports LLC (hereinafter "Massimo") are pleased to explain the emission control system warranty on your Off-Road vehicle. New off-road motor vehicles must be designed, built and equipped to meet U.S. EPA Federal and California anti-smog standards. Massimo must warrant the emission control system on your vehicle for 5,000 km, or at least 30 months, whichever comes first, provided that there has been no abuse, neglect or improper maintenance of your vehicle. This off-road vehicle was designed to meet the emission standards for 10,000 km, or five years, whichever comes first.

Your emission control system warranty covers components whose failure would increase an engine's emissions of any regulated pollutant

Where a warrantable condition exists, Massimo will repair your vehicle at no cost to you, including diagnosis, parts and labor.

If an emission-related part on your vehicle is defective, the part will be repaired or replaced by Massimo. This is your EMISSION CONTROL SYSTEM WARRANTY.

NOTICE! Use of this vehicle in any type of competitive event completely and absolutely voids this and all other warranties offered by Massimo.

OWNER'S WARRANTY RESPONSIBILITIES

As the vehicle owner, you are responsible for the performance of the required maintenance listed in your owner's manual. Massimo recommends that you retain all receipts covering maintenance on your vehicle, but Massimo cannot deny warranty solely for the lack of receipts or for your failure to ensure the performance of all scheduled maintenance.

You are responsible for presenting your vehicle to the Massimo dealer as soon as a problem exists. The warranty repairs should be completed in a reasonable amount of time, not to exceed 30 days.

As the vehicle owner, you should be aware that Massimo may deny your warranty coverage if your vehicle or a part has failed due to abuse, neglect, improper maintenance or unapproved modifications.

If you use your vehicle in any type of competitive event, this warranty is immediately and completely void.

Massimo Motor Sports LLC warrants that each new off-road vehicle:

A. is designed, built and equipped so as to conform at the time of initial retail purchase with all applicable regulations of the United States Environmental Protection Agency, and

B. is free from defects in material and workmanship which cause such vehicle to fail to conform to applicable regulations of the United States Environmental Protection Agency for the periods specified above.

I. Coverage. Warranty defects shall be remedied during customary business hours at any authorized Massimo dealer located within the United States of America in compliance with the Clean Air Act and applicable regulations of the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Any part or parts replaced under this warranty shall become the property of Massimo.

II. Limitations This Emission Control System Warranty shall not cover any of the following:

A. Repair or replacement as a result of

- (1) accident,
- (2) misuse
- (3) repairs improperly performed or replacements improperly installed, unless performed by a Massimo authorized dealer,
- (4) use of improper replacement parts or accessories not conforming to specifications set forth by Massimo, which adversely affect performance and/or
- (5) Use in competitive racing or related events.

B. Inspections, replacement of parts and other services and adjustments required for required maintenance.

C. Any vehicle equipped with an odometer or hour meter on which the odometer mileage or hour meter reading has been changed so that actual mileage cannot be readily determined.

III. Limited Liability

A. The liability of Massimo under this Emission Control System Warranty is limited solely to the remedying of defects in material or workmanship by an authorized Massimo dealer at its place of business during customary business hours. This warranty does not cover inconvenience or loss of use of the vehicle or transportation of the vehicle to or from the Massimo dealer. Massimo shall not be liable for any other expenses, loss or damage, whether direct, incidental, consequential or exemplary arising in connection with the sale or use of or inability to use the vehicle for any purpose. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of any incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations may not apply to you.

B. No express emission control system warranty is given by Massimo except as specifically set forth herein. Any emission control system warranty implied by law, including any warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, is limited to the express emission control system warranty terms stated in this warranty. The foregoing statements of warranty are exclusive and in lieu of all other remedies. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitations may not apply to you.

C. No dealer is authorized to modify this Limited Emission Control System Warranty issued by Massimo.

IV. **LEGAL RIGHTS.** This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

V. This warranty is in addition to the limited vehicle warranty.

VI. **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.** Any replacement part that is equivalent in performance and durability may be used in the performance of any maintenance or repairs by the owner. However, Massimo is not liable for these parts. The owner is responsible for the performance of all required maintenance. Such maintenance may be performed at a service establishment or by any individual. The warranty period begins when the vehicle is placed into service.

Review your owner's manual and follow the **scheduled maintenance chart** found in the manual [section 8.] This required maintenance must be performed to keep your warranty valid.

Should you have any issues with your Massimo please contact your closest authorized service center. It's important to bring your Massimo UTV into one these service locations after **first 20 hours of use OR 200 miles**, whichever occurs first. This is your first and most important scheduled maintenance for your new Massimo UTV. This first scheduled service will change all critical fluids, check all connectors, both front and rear differential seals, suspension and transmission. As well as give you a good opportunity to ask any questions that you may have after your first 20 hours OR 200 miles behind the wheel of your new Massimo UTV.

Below are a few tips for taking care of your Massimo UTV: Again, please read your owner's manual.

- **Use only 92-octane or ethanol free gas.**
- **Check your oil every time you fill up your gas.** If it is getting very dark, please change the oil immediately. If it is black, disconnect the 2 rubber hoses next to the oil filter that are going to the oil cooler up by the radiator. Point one hose down into the drain pan and apply some air pressure to the other line to blow out that nasty old oil before filling. (Reconnect the 2 hoses and check tightness when done)
- **Keep the air filter clean and oiled.** A dirty air filter will cause problems for your engine. You can order replacement air filter foam from the Massimo web store. www.massimomotor.com
- **Use only genuine Massimo engine oil and oil filters for your oil change.** Massimo engine oil is specially engineered for your Massimo unit. You can also order it from Massimo web store or local Massimo Dealer.
- **Drive in low range most of the time.** Only use high range for cruising at 30-40 MPH. Low range will run well past 30 MPH. High range is like 3rd gear and is much harder on the clutches because of the higher gear ratio.

Again, thank you for your business and with proper care of your Massimo UTV by following the scheduled maintenance chart your new Massimo will give you years of operation and hopefully give you many great experiences.
