

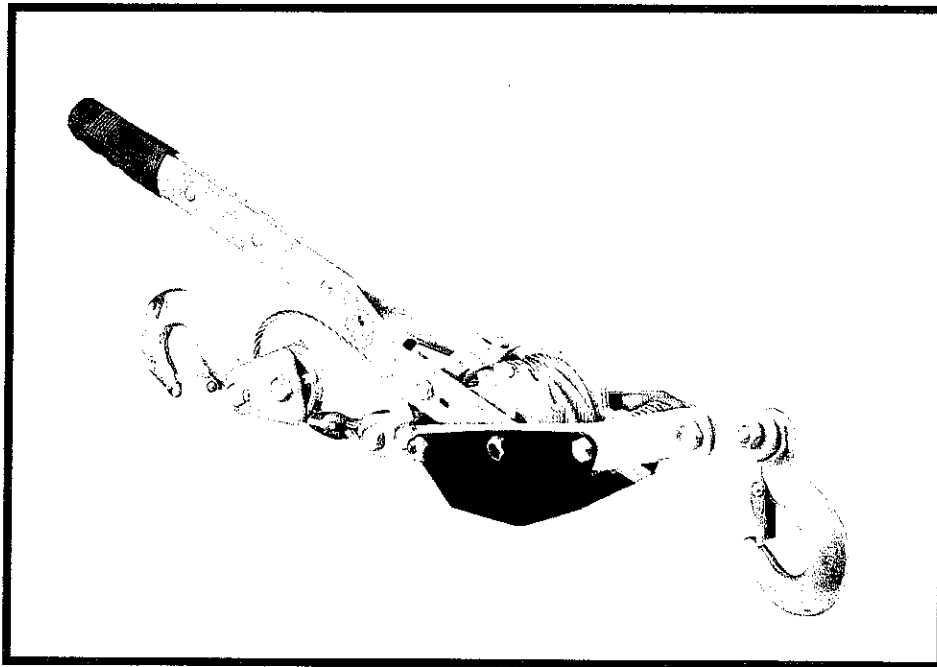

## WARNINGS



1. Read, study, understand and follow all instructions and warnings before using this product.
2. Do NOT exceed the rated capacity.
3. ALWAYS keep tension on the cable while operating.
4. Do NOT subject the cable puller to sudden shock loads.
5. Avoid abrupt handle movement when releasing the load. Apply pressure with an even, steady force.
6. Do NOT use handle extension device or "cheater" pipe to lengthen the handle. This will damage the cable puller and the load.
7. Do NOT allow anyone around or under the tensioned load.
8. Do NOT operate the product if it has a frayed, kinked, twisted or damaged cable.
9. Do NOT wrap the cable around the load or around any other object.
10. Do NOT hook back onto the cable puller.
11. Do NOT pull the cable over or around a corner.
12. Do NOT use the cable puller as a hoist. It is not designed as a lifting device.
13. Do NOT use the cable puller as a towing device.
14. ONLY use hand power to operate the product.
15. ALWAYS make sure that there is a positive engagement of the puller hook to the load.
16. ALWAYS make sure that the hooks are secured to load before tensioning.
17. Do NOT operate the cable puller with less than 3 wraps of cable on the drum.
18. NO alterations shall be made to this product.

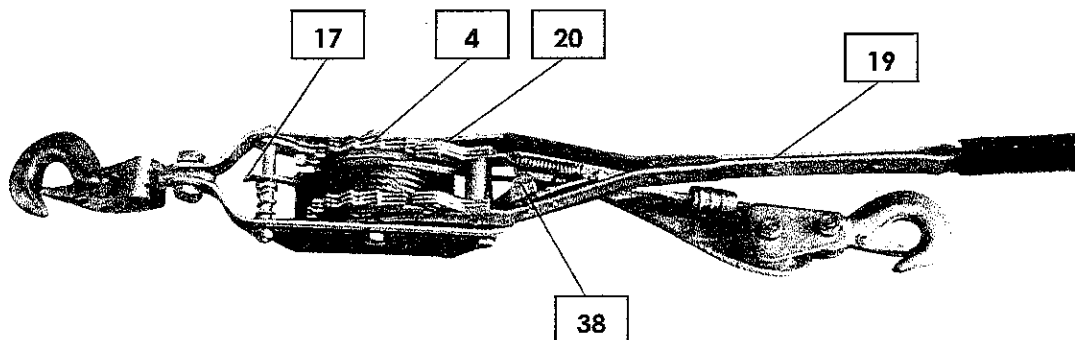

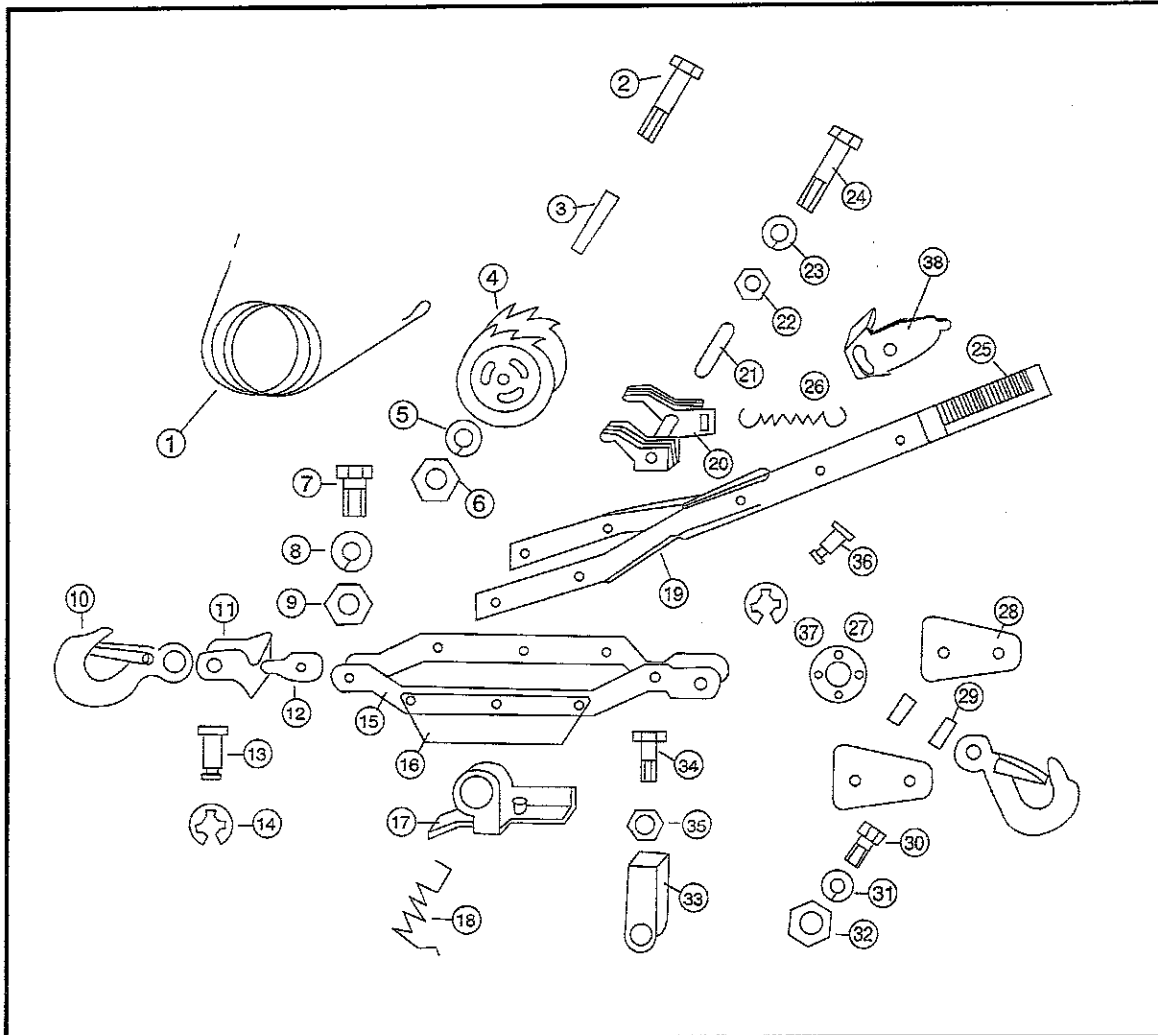
## PARTS DIAGRAM

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



### WARNING!

Never attempt to disengage Stop Pawl while under tension from load.

1. Attach fixed hook (10) to a stationary object.
2. Hold cable puller in an upright position. Move switch (38) to up position. Press stop pawl lever (17) upward to release tension on ratchet wheel (4). Pull cable out to desired length.
3. Attach cable hook (39) to the object to be moved.
4. Press switch (38) down.

5. Pull the object by firmly gripping the handle (19) and moving it back and forth with an even, steady force. This will allow the cable to be reeled in, moving the object.
6. After moving object to desired location, move switch (38) to up position. Next move handle (19) all the way toward fixed hook (10) until it engages the stop pawl (17). Push handle (19) down, and then raise it up. This releases tension one notch at a time. Repeat this motion until there is enough slack to unhook the cable puller from the object.

## **MAINTENANCE**

1. Visual inspection MUST be made prior to each use of the cable puller. Check for bent, worn, kinked, frayed or damaged parts. Any cable puller that appears to be damaged in any way should not be used until a manufacturer or supplier's authorized repair center makes necessary repairs.
2. Inspect cable puller immediately if it has been subjected to abnormal load or shock. It is recommended that a manufacturer or supplier's authorized repair center make this inspection.
3. Keep cable puller free from dirt, grease or other debris.
4. Any cable puller that appears to be damaged in any way or operates abnormally shall be removed from service immediately.
5. BECAUSE OF THE POTENTIAL HAZARDS ASSOCIATED WITH THE MISUSE OF EQUIPMENT OF THIS TYPE, NO MODIFICATIONS SHALL BE MADE TO PRODUCT.

## **ADDITIONAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

- Understand the application, limitations and potential hazards associated with the cable puller.
- Keep work area clean and clutter-free.
- Do Not wear loose or ill fitting clothing. Remove ties, watches, rings and other loose jewelry. Contain or tie back long hair.
- Keep children and non-essential persons away from the operating area. Be aware of the location of other persons assisting you.
- Do NOT operate the puller if you are tired or under the influence of alcohol, drugs or intoxicating medications.
- Store equipment when not in use. Keep in dry location and out of reach of children.
