Re: Shelf life and date coding

Regarding the shelf life of our product PB Blaster, be advised that we do not recognize an official expiration date. As long as the container is intact and dispenses as designed, the performance of the contents will not degrade over time.

We understand that many organizations require a specific time period to be entered for record keeping purposes, and in those cases we recommend 5 (five) years.

The Blaster Chemical Companies, Inc. utilizes a Julian dating system for the date coding of its products. This can be read as follows: the first two digits denote the year (i.e. 03 = 2003 \$ 11 = 2011) the next three digits denote the actual day of the year (i.e. 005 = Jan 5 & 365 = Dec 31); a sixth and final digit may exist as an internal code
