DON'T SHED ON ME

From fur balls to wiry short hair, shedding is one of the biggest frustrations a pet owner can feel. Below are a handful of suggestions to lessen this annoyance.



TRY A CHANGE IN DIET

If your pooch is shedding, start by seeing if a different diet helps. Eggs, fish oil, and steamed veggies add much needed moisture that results in a healthier skin and coat.

Brush, Brush, Brush!

Brushing regularly and using de-shedding tools can help remove excess fur. Choosing the right brush is important.



Rub-A-Dub Dog

Regular baths rinse away loose hair. An oatmeal-based shampoo is less likely to dry out or irritate skin.

Be Resourceful

Run a damp paper towel across your pet's coat to quickly pick up extra fur. Lint rollers can be used on furniture and clothes, or even directly on pets.



There are no magical cures to completely stop shedding. However, a few dog breeds like poodles, terriers and shih tzus are low to no shedding dogs. The sphynx cat is almost hairless, yet requires special grooming since this breed is not designed to clean itself.
