### SAFETY FIRST!

#### LIVING ROOM

Put away children's toys.

Keep shoes and pillows off the floor and laundry behind closed doors.

Check dressers and closets for furry friends before closing them.

Make sure pull-cords on blinds are shortened and not accessible.



#### KITCHEN/BATHROOM

Keep cabinets and trash cans closed.

Be certain all sharp objects are out of reach and secure.

Block small spaces where curious pets may get trapped.

Keep toilet lid closed to prevent drinking or falling in.



#### GARAGE/BASEMENT

Make sure antifreeze and other harmful chemicals are not easily opened or knocked over.

Check under your car hood—cats may hide there for warmth.

Check washer and dryer before using, especially with kittens.



Redirect your pet's playful focus away from dangerous items with a variety of toys stored in designated areas.
