A Leash On The Good Life!



Larger dogs require a stronger leash than smaller dogs. For best control, a leash should be four to six feet long. The quality and durability of the leash and clasp is most important.



Fresh Air Possibilities

Outdoor kennels and pet gazebos are a great way to allow your dogs to be outside.

When choosing a doghouse, make sure it is big enough for standing and turning around comfortably.



Choose The Right Collar

Collars should have a snug fit and not slip over your pet's head. Leather or nylon collars typically work well. Pronged collars, gentle leaders and harnesses can be used depending on your dog's size, disposition, and training needs.



When used properly, tie outs are a good way to allow your dog to enjoy the outdoors. It gives them valuable time outside, but you should never use this option as a permanent means of confinement. Many communities have passed laws against long-term chaining.
