



AMERAUCANAS

Ameraucanas come in both a large and a bantam variety and are often called the Easter egg chicken. They lay eggs in shades of blue, and even have blue (or “slate”) legs. Rather than ear tufts, they have fuller muffs over their ears and a beard, and are very hardy and sweet tempered. Although less rare than their cousins the Araucanas, they are still an uncommon breed.
