



ANCONA

The Ancona is a relatively rare breed. It has a beautiful “mottled” color pattern of black with white spots, and both Single Comb & Rose Comb varieties are accepted by the American Poultry Association. Like other Mediterranean breeds, Anconas are closely feathered, active, good foragers and good layers. They stand frost and snow quite well and will surpass Leghorn chickens as winter layers.
