



BLACK MINORCA

The Black Minorca was named after the Spanish island where it was once found in vast numbers. They are the largest of the Mediterranean breeds, with roosters maturing to an average of 9 lbs and hens maturing to around 7 and 1/2 lbs. Their glossy wide black feathers lay closely against rather narrow bodies, with distinctive white ear lobes. They are layers of large white eggs and their large combs make them more appropriate for warmer climates
