



BRAHMA – BUFF, DARK, LIGHT

Brahmas are gentle birds with profuse, fluffy feathering throughout their bodies including feathered legs and feet and require well drained soil where they are kept. Originally from India, these birds were bred for meat production, though the hens lay relatively decently and are great setters and mothers. This fancy breed of chicken makes a great pet for its quiet and tame nature and tolerance to the cold. While not a power layer, you can expect three or so medium-size brown eggs from this bird per week.
