## **KHAKI CAMPBELLS DUCKS**

Khaki Campbells exceed most duck and chicken breeds in egg production, with some strains averaging 300 white eggs per year. Campbells are extremely cold hardy, are excellent foragers, and are at home on land as well as in water. They eat large quantities of slugs, snails, insects, algae, and mosquitos from ponds. They do not require swimming water to stay healthy. Campbells are growing in popularity as an egg-layer and backyard duck.
