



LAKENVELDER – GOLD, SILVER

The Golden Lakenvelder is a beautiful and rare variety, with the Silver Lakenvelder being somewhat more common. They are good, dependable producers of medium white eggs. This rare breed is a non-setter. Lakenvelders are 4-5 lbs at maturity. The breed is an active, capable forager with high predator avoidance built into its nature. They are entertaining and fun birds to watch in the yard. Being good flyers, they can often clear fences, although they do adapt well to confinement if given enough space. They are economical eaters and do best in warmer climates.
