



ROUEN DUCKS

Rouen ducks are a large bodied breed of duck with the same color pattern as the wild Mallard. They are docile birds that are valued for their meat, but are poor layers, producing only 35-125 eggs yearly. Rouen ducks are slow to mature. While this slow maturation (6-8 months) makes them impractical for commercial meat production, Rouens are great for ponds and small scale production.
