



WYANDOTTES - GOLDEN AND SILVER LACED, BLACK, BLUE, BUFF

Wyandottes are a docile, dual-purpose breed kept for both eggs and meat. They lay a nicely shaped, good sized egg, varying from light to rich brown. The Wyandotte is a breed that suits both free range and confinement in runs. They tend to be friendly, and not flighty. They can be very vocal, uttering soft clucks on a regular basis. Cold weather doesn't seem to bother them at all and they are known to lay straight through the winter. They appear in a wide variety of color patterns and are popular show birds.
