Rather than fighting these instincts or punishing the dog for doing what comes naturally, it's far more productive to find acceptable ways to satisfy these instincts, one of the best ways is healthy play. Physical and mental development, emotions and behavior can all be influenced by how your dog plays.

Games like fetch, tug and chase satisfy a dog's natural needs, as well as strengthen the bond between you and your dog. Play helps the dog expend excess energy, which is extremely important for appropriate behavior. In order to be well adjusted and happy, dogs need to play.

Work is a type of play for dogs and providing toys will mentally and physically stimulate your dog. Stuffing healthy treats into a KONG keeps dogs happily working and out of trouble for long periods of time.  
NOTE: Be sure to adjust bowl feeding as needed to maintain a healthy diet when using the KONG to feed meals or treats. Always seek the help of a vet or trainer if your dog exhibits any behavioral problems.

**Supervise your dog until you are certain it can use KONG safely alone.**

**Clean and inspect KONG toys frequently.** Look for cracks, separations and/or missing pieces. Flex your dry KONG toys and inspect it from all angles. Loose pieces larger than a food nugget can be harmful if swallowed. Worn and damaged KONG toys must be replaced immediately.

**YOUR DOG'S SAFETY IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** If you think your dog has swallowed a toy fragment, promptly call your veterinarian.

**Proper Sizing.** It is important to use the right size of KONG for your dog to have the safest, most enjoyable, and longest-lasting experience.

**Multiple Dog Households.** If you have multiple dogs in your household, only provide KONG toys sized for the largest and/or toughest chewer in the house.

**Determined Chewers.** If your dog destroys a KONG toy in a short period of time, try a larger size. If you are using the red KONG Classic toy, consider using a black KONG Extreme toy.
